Notice of Safety Zone

June 24, 2010

Notice is hereby given of a safety zone under Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.7(a), which may not be entered without the prior permission of the Coast Guard Captain of the Port.

The Coast Guard is establishing a safety zone on the navigable waters of Corpus Christi Bay within the area bounded by a 600-foot radius circle centered on position 27[deg]49'07"N and 097[deg]12'32"W. This safety zone will be established in the vicinity of Ingleside, Texas from approximately 9:30 p.m until 10:15 p.m. on Friday July 02, 2010 and from approximately 9:30 p.m. until 10:15 p.m. on Sunday July 04, 2010. In the interest of public safety, general navigation within the safety zone will be restricted during the specified date and times. Except for participants and vessels authorized by the Coast Guard Captain of the Port or his representative, no person or vessel may enter or remain in the regulated area.

Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 165.23 prohibits any unauthorized person or vessel from entering into, transiting through, or remaining in the safety zones without permission of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. Each person and vessel allowed within the safety zones shall obey any direction or order of the Captain of the Port or his designated representative. If the need for the safety zones ends before the scheduled termination time, the Captain of the Port will cease enforcement of the safety zones and will announce that fact via Broadcast Notice to Mariners.

PENALTY: Persons violating this safety zone may be liable pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1232.
